



## **The Creative Center's Virtual Training Institute for Artists and Administrators in Arts-In-Healthcare and Creative Aging 2022 throughout the month of October!**

Join national leaders in the field at The Creative Center at University Settlement throughout the month of October in our long-standing tradition of training artists and administrators to replicate our best practices model in a variety of healthcare settings. Our training, to be held virtually via Zoom, is funded by the National Endowment for the Arts and the NYC Department of Cultural Affairs and will focus on the role of the arts in healthcare and creative aging. Artists and administrators, in both the arts and healthcare, will be given everything needed to create high quality arts programming in hospitals, healthcare centers, nursing homes, long-term care facilities, and hospice settings as well as community spaces, senior centers and residential facilities serving older adults and their caregivers across the aging spectrum through a series of seminars, presentations, hands-on workshops and virtual "site visits." We recognize that arts and health spaces are rife with racial and economic inequity and welcome the opportunity to interrogate these topics during every presentation. Sessions will take place at various times, from October 11 - October 29, and recordings will be available to those who aren't able to attend every session.

- Artmaking and Dementia Care in Theory and Practice
- Healthcare Artists-In-Residence: What Do You Need to Make It Work

- Opening Minds Through Art: An Intergenerational Program
- Museum Panel: Understanding Engagement and Access for Older Adult Populations
